# **Notice of Online Public Information Centre #2**

Highway 11/17 Four-Laning from west of Highway 582 to Coughlin Road Detail Design and Class Environmental Assessment Study

#### THE STUDY

WSP, on behalf of the Ministry of the Transportation (MTO), is undertaking the Detail Design and Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for the four-lane expansion of Highway 11/17 for 8 km from 1.3 km west of Highway 582 to Coughlin Road as shown in the key plan.

The EA approved plan within the study limits included:

- Expansion of Highway 11/17 to four lanes by twinning on the existing alignment; and
- Improvements / modifications to select intersecting side-roads.

In 1997, an Environmental Study Report as prepared to document the proposed plan for the four-laning this portion of Highway 11/17. The project was approved and subsequently designated (protected) in 2003.

# THE PROCESS

This study is following the approved environmental planning process for Group 'B' projects under the *Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities* (2000).


Following Public Information Centre (PIC) #1 held on November 8, 2017, the Project Team prepared and filed an Addendum to the original 1997 Environmental Study Report (ESR) to document the proposed changes to the original design decisions (i.e. minor highway alignment revisions in some sections, shifting the Valley Road East alignment to the east by 12.5 m, and an increase in right-of-way width from 45 m to 55 m (minimum) on the north (twinned) side of the highway). MTO received EA approval to proceed with the proposed changes in May 2018.
